The Department is the support structure used by the Prime Minister to promote and coordinate government action on anti-drug policies.


### **KEY TASKS OF DPA**

#### The Department sees to:

- promoting, directing and coordinating Government actions aimed at countering the spread of drug use, drug addiction and related alcohol addiction,
- promoting and implementing activities in collaboration with the public administrations competent in the specific field, associations, therapeutic communities, shelters operating in the field of prevention, treatment, rehabilitation and reintegration,
- ensuring the compiling of documentation on drug addiction, designation and update of methodologies for the detection, storage and development,
- evaluation and outsourcing of data and information on drug addiction





# Memorandum of Understanding JANUARY 2022 GTFI (Italian Forensic Toxicologists Group) & DPA


The parties, in their respective capabilities and functions, are engaged in the following areas of cooperation:

- Sexual violence and crimes under the influence of incapacitating substances.
- Correlation of drug and alcohol deaths
  - (GTFI gathers data, processes it, DPA subsequently proceeds to evaluate and includes it in the annual report to Parliament)
- Checks on workers with tasks deemed risky to the health of others.
- DUI/ DWI, road fatalities/ personal and substantial injury, driver's license renewal.
- Identifying and determining the active ingredients under Presidential Decree 309/90, in seizures of narcotic substances and evaluating their psychotropic activity and potential for injury for the assessment of criminal cases or the application of administrative fines in the case of detention for personal use.
- Trade and use of doping substances and counterfeit drugs.



## **EMCDDA**




It is one of 22 Community Agencies of the European Commission and is the drug information center of the European Union.



It was established in 1993 with headquarters in Lisbor



It is tasked with providing the EU and member states with "objective, reliable and comparable information on drugs and drug addiction."



Publishes annual European Report on the evolution of the phenomenon in Europe



## NFP



It is the national authorities designated by the relevant governments that provide EMCDDA with data and information on drugs and drug addiction



Stipulate an annual contract with EMCDDA for the fulfillment of both mandatory and voluntary activities of cooperation in the exchange of data and information



# THE HORIZONTAL WORKING PARTY ON DRUGS (HDG)

The Horizontal Drugs Group, established in 1997, is an interdisciplinary working group of the Council of the European Union with the task of initiating, monitoring and coordinating all activities concerning the drug sector, developing the Council's anti-drug policy.

Meets in Brussels in monthly sessions, which are often supplemented by political dialogue meetings with non-EU countries

Reviews proposals and drafts submitted by Member States or EU bodies regarding initiatives, measures and regulatory measures inspired by the EU Drug Strategy and Action Plan and approves resolutions, including those to be submitted to the Narcotics Commission.

Participants in the meetings are EU member states, the emcdda, the European Commission and the EU Council Secretariat.





### **Pompidou Group**



Founded in1971, at the initiative of French President Georges Pompidou



In 1980, the Group was incorporated into the Council of Europe



There are currently 42 member states

The Pompidou Group's mission is to be contributive to the development of evidence-based policies in member states. The Pompidou Group promotes human rights-based approaches to drugs.


#### **GENDER RAPPORTEUR OF THE POMPIDOU GROUP**
